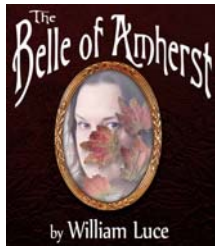

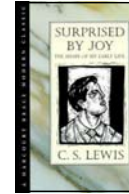

## Sunday Morning Childcare Update

**There has been a change to our summer childcare abilities that we want to share with all families.** For the remainder of the summer we will only be providing childcare downstairs for the younger kids. We will NOT be providing childcare for the older youth, who typically meet upstairs with Chandra. This change is necessary because we currently have a reduced number of childcare providers. Our plan is to hire 2 additional childcare workers as soon as possible.
